
### Retail opportunities in a vibrant downtown

- Numerous Newburyport marinas with more than 1,500 slips draw yachts and boaters from around the globe.



- Manchester Regional Airport is located 50 miles north and an estimated 58 minutes away.






### One of New England's most attractive downtowns
